MASKS AND FACE COVERINGS

All students participating in CYSO activities will have the opportunity to wear masks if they choose to do so. Students must provide their own masks if they choose to wear one.

<u>Students and parents should be monitoring for any symptoms of illness</u>. Students should NOT attend rehearsal if they have any symptoms of illness. Students with any signs of COVID-related symptoms will be sent home and must follow local guidelines.

Students who exhibit major or minor symptoms of COVID-19 will be asked to stay home. They can return to rehearsal:

• If they only have minor symptoms and the symptoms resolve within 24 hours - no test required.

If a student begins exhibiting symptoms of illness while at rehearsal, they will be asked to wear a mask until they can go home.

ISOLATION & QUARANTINE

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, they must isolate:

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If no symptoms or symptoms are resolving (much better) after 5 days, they can return to rehearsal (if they have a fever, they must stay home for 24 hours after the fever resolves)
- If a student still has a fever or symptoms haven't improved after 5 days, they must stay in isolation until:
 - o They have no fever for at least 24 hours (without using fever reducing medication) AND
 - o Other symptoms have improved (for example, cough and shortness of breath have improved)
- Mask wearing will be encouraged for 5 additional days when around others.

If a student is exposed to someone with COVID-19, it is recommended that they:

• Wear a mask around others for 10 days

***Englewood Schools prohibits parents from entering the building. Only staff and CYSO students will be allowed to enter the building on Monday nights for rehearsal.
